## ADMISSIONS

- 1) The Principal has the absolute right to admit or not to admit the child to the school and the decision of the Principal shall be final and binding on the parents.
- 2) Prescribed application forms for registration can be obtained from the school office for admission from nursery to class-10. Registration of name is no guarantee for admission, the school will not entertain admission to any classes in the mid of an academic year.
- 3) An official birth certificate from the Municipal Council or Gram Panchayat in support of the date of birth entered in the registration form and four passport size color photo graphs should be submitted at the time of admission.
- 4) A pupil coming from other school must produce an original leaving school leaving certificate from the school last attended and a pupil coming from another state / district must produce a migration certificate duly signed by the education inspector of the area in that state & district.
- 5) The Lower age limit for admission to:
  - **Grade- I** is six years as on 31st December.
  - **KG - 2** is five years as on 31st December.
  - **KG - I** is four years as on 31st December.
  - **Nursery** is three years as on 31st December.

**WITHDRAWALS**

- For withdrawal of a pupil from the school, one week's notice must be given in writing
